Amafa Institute invites applications from suitably qualified young people aged 18 - 35 for exciting 12-month internship opportunities to be based at **KwaBulawayo Royal Palace** (outside Eshowe), **eMakhosini: The Valley of the Zulu Kings** and **KwaZulu Cultural Museum** (both sites located at Ulundi). Incumbents must be residents of the local areas mentioned above.

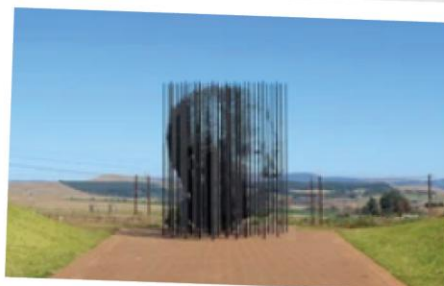

MINIMUM KEY REQUIREMENTS

- 3-year national Diploma/Degree in Heritage Tourism.
- Knowledge of the history / heritage of KwaZulu-Natal.
- Computer literacy and ability to work with complex computer programmes including AI.

DUTIES

- Provide guided tours to exhibitions, heritage sites and izigodlo and amadlinza of the Zulu kings.
- Promote heritage sites of the province.
- Provide historical knowledge about the history and heritage of the province.
- Interact with schools & stakeholders
- Record visitor statistics using online platform / programmes

- These opportunities are based at KwaBulawayo, Emakhosini and KwaZulu Cultural Museum.
- Incumbents will be expected to dress in a manner that respect these sensitive sites of the Zulu Kingdom.
- Applicants are expected to be fluent in both Isizulu and English. Knowledge of Afrikaans and other language is encouraged.
